## **Admission Requirements and Prerequisites**

(supplemental coursework may be added to degree as needed)

- 1. Earned Bachelor's degree in Music from accredited institution, minimum cumulative GPA 3.0.
- 2. Acceptance to the graduate school and HHSOM graduate program OR
  - a. At least three letters of recommendation
  - b. A written essay on your preparedness for graduate or further education, your career aspirations for the teacher certification. Please include your experiences in educational or relevant settings, and any contributions you have made or aspire to make to a diverse, heterogeneous community of learners and teachers
- 3. Interview with Music Education Faculty
- 4. Obtain Pre-Service Certificate (background checks and ethics training and exam)
- 5. Pass the Hodgson School of Music Piano Proficiency examination (or Piano 1-4)
- 6. Beginning conducting course from previous degree
- 7. Monthly Attendance to Music Education Seminars is required (every 4th Wednesday of the month during Common Hour)
