Dr. Burnett, the UGA Voice Faculty, and I are happy to invite you and your best tenor and bass students to The Hugh Hodgson School of Music for this year's modified *High School Choral Day: TTBB Edition* on Thursday, September 23rd at the UGA Performing Arts Center. In light of the state of the pandemic and the spread of the Delta variant, we have decided to scale back the number of eligible participants this fall in an effort to provide a safer environment for our students and guests. We plan to offer a comparable SSAA Choral Day in January of 2022.

This is a wonderful and unique opportunity for your best and most dedicated tenors and basses to rehearse and perform in our world-class facilities, to work with and make personal connections with our conducting and voice faculties, and to enjoy the fellowship and artistic camaraderie of the collegiate singers of the UGA Glee Club and Hodgson Singers. Additionally, you and your students will enjoy a brief recital presented by UGA voice students.

Information and registration paperwork for the High School Choral Day: TTBB Edition, including an information form and a schedule of events is attached in this email. **The deadline for registration is Monday, September 20, 2021.**

As always, the repertoire for the day-long festival is designed to give your students a variety of musical experiences. We will perform Randall Thompson's rousing *The Last Words of David* and *The Wellerm*an – a New Zealand sea shanty arranged by Michael Ware, made famous, recently by a video on TikTok.

INFORMATION SHEET

- The UGA High Choral Day 2021 will take place on Thursday, September 23rd from 9:30am until 2:15pm at the Performing Arts Center on East Campus. Participating schools/singers are expected to be present for the entire day of activities. A snack/light lunch break will be observed at 11:30am for guest singers to eat a snack/lunch that they brought, or to purchase slices of pizza offered by our UGA Student ACDA Chapter.
- The cost per student is \$20.00. Registration can be completed using the enclosed registration form and mailed check(s), or online using the UGA online marketplace:

- Schools are encouraged to bring *only* their most motivated, prepared, and engaged tenors and basses. There is no limit to the number of singers a school can bring, however.
- Online registration using the link above is the preferred method of registration. If you need to, or prefer to register by mail and check, please know that registration forms are due with payment to the Choral Activities Office by Monday, September 20, 2020. Mailed Choral Day registration checks should be made out to "<u>Hugh Hodgson School of Music</u>." Please email a pdf of your registration form to Dr. Bara or Sarah Frook Gallo prior to placing it in the mail.
- Choral Day Check-In will be open on the day of the event from 8:45am until 9:30am on the day of the event at the drop-off area in front of the UGA Performing Arts Center immediately adjacent to the Hugh Hodgson School of Music (260 River Road, Athens, GA)
- It is understood that teachers will serve as *in loco parentis* throughout the festival, and will be in possession of all relevant permission and emergency medical forms for their students.
- Schools wishing to pre-order a pizza lunch provided by our student ACDA Chapter (\$5 for 2 slices, chips, water), can do so using the attached form. This is OPTIONAL and can be paid for at the event using cash or credit card. Schools are also welcome to pack lunches or snacks instead. If you register using the online marketplace, please email Dr. Bara or Sarah F. Gallo your pizza order.
- ***** We will NOT have time in this schedule to use campus eateries or leave campus for lunch.
- Sponsoring high school choral conductors should provide preliminary preparation of the repertoire to ensure that all pitches and rhythms are learned prior to arrival. All students must have their own music and pencil. No music will be available for borrowing and no copying services will be provided on the day of the event. Schools observed handing out the repertoire to students on the day of the event will risk dismissal and ineligibility for future UGA Choral Day involvement.
